

#### Finish:

No punching is needed when crossing the finish line as the time is taken electronically through the SI-card on the finish line.

After crossing the finish line, athletes may be requested to sit down immediately on the leader's chair. In this case a team official may hand over a jacket or some other clothing to an official which will be passed on to the runner. Changing of clothes is not allowed as the athlete is live on TV.

The leader can follow the race on a TV-screen, she/he may only leave the stage according to the instructions of the organiser.

#### Quarantine in Palasport Bellinzona

Respect embargoed areas while driving to quarantine WC and clothes, warm-up map
After warm up return to quarantine is possible

#### Pre-start:

Pre-start marked at border of warm-up map (600 m), don't leave map perimeter Way pre-start to start: 8 minutes before start time

#### Start:

Exiting of the two last boxes is allowed from organiser when previous runners are outside view


No GPS tracking devices from organisation. Personal GPS-devices are allowed according to IOF-rules.

Time pre-start to start: 7 minutes before start time


#### Start:

There will be a short ramp downhill after the start, then continue up to the start triangle.

#### Map change (SF):

After last control of 1st part, follow 30 m taped route over a bridge to the map change.

Throw away the old map

New map is on the table.

After taking the map follow 80 m taped route to the start triangle.

Sequence number of controls continues after 1st part





#### Map symbols:

## **EOC 2018 Questions**



Are the paths from the parking to the quarantine marked? Parking is just outside quarantine for both SQ and SF

Are the paths from the quarantine to the arena marked? Yes

How much % is hard ground and how much park ground? Almost all hard ground.

Can cars be expected in competition area?

Competition areas are closed to traffic. Please count with very limited vehicle traffic locals needing to exit, public transport, safety cars, ...)



## **EOC 2018 Questions**



Where is the map change positioned along the course? No comment

Is it always olive color behind closed gates?

No, sometimes marked as house. Otherwise olive behind.

Is there a code number near the sequence number?

Good question! Photo is related to sprint relay, in sprint competitions no code numbers!

Are the runners allowed to leave the arena straight after having finished their race?

Yes, according to cooldown map (re-enter competition area is not allowed)

The clock on pre-start does it show real time or call-up time? Call-up time

Are there water bottles in the finish? Yes



## **EOC 2018 Questions**



Are there coaching zones, if no is coaching allowed? No coaching zones, coaching is allowed.

Is there shade provided between pre-start and start?

Can runners leave the arena after they have finished? Yes

Is there water at the pre-start?

Are there artificial fences and if yes, do they cross the entire road? It's possible and if that's the case the whole road is closed-off and it's clear to the athlete.
